### JOB SUMMARY:

In accordance with the Vision, Purpose, and Values, and strategic direction of the Vancouver Island Health Authority, patient safety is a priority and a responsibility shared by everyone at VIHA; as such, the requirement to continuously improve quality and safety is inherent in all aspects of this position.

Reports to the Lead Technologist and is responsible for General Radiography procedures in the Medical Imaging Department, portable and operating rooms. This position maintains responsibility for the provision of general radiography procedures and results for the assigned permanent night, evening, or weekend shifts.

### TYPICAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Verifies all patient information is present and correct and then proceeds with radiographic examination. Performs medical imaging examinations as assigned to the work area.
2. Complies with radiation protection regulations to ensure the safety of patients and personnel.
3. Operates all major and accessory equipment adhering to correct procedures.
4. Records and processes images on various media according to established standards.
5. Adapts standard examination procedures as required by departmental protocols/policies in non-routine situations such as specialized requests by physicians.
6. Records examinations performed and completes requisitions with required information.
7. Transports patients to and from the emergency Department to the Medical Imaging Department.
8. Participates in the process of continuous improvement of services provided by the radiography section.
9. Participates in orientation and in-service education programs for departmental staff.
10. Contacts referring physicians to clarify information/procedures as required during the performance of duties.
11. Troubleshoots equipment for possible malfunctions and reports to the Lead Technologist and arranges for service if required.
12. Performs other related duties as assigned.
