JOB SUMMARY:

In accordance with the Vision, Purpose, and Values, and strategic direction of the Vancouver Island Health Authority, patient safety is a priority and a responsibility shared by everyone at VIHA; as such, the requirement to continuously improve quality and safety is inherent in all aspects of this position.

Reporting to the Lead Physiotherapist, the staff Physiotherapist assesses, treats, educates and evaluates a care plan for individual patients. The physiotherapist also educates other health disciplines and the public in the various aspects of physiotherapy patient care.

TYPICAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. To assess and plan treatments for assigned inpatients or outpatients on receipt of a referral from a physician with hospital admitting privileges or, when appropriate, using the criteria for standing orders.
- 2. To keep comprehensive treatment and progress records.
- 3. To liase with medical staff concerning the patient's treatment and progress.
- 4. To communicate effectively with other health disciplines.
- 5. To educate patient about their physical condition and self-management and to interpret treatment programs to their families and other health personnel.
- 6. To be responsible for the safety of the patient while receiving physiotherapy treatment and to be aware of the contra-indications to specific forms of treatment, the potential hazards involved in various procedures used, and the precautions which must be employed and taught to the patient.
- 7. To attend patient care or patient review meetings as required.
- 8. To participate in the Quality Assurance program by setting standards, auditing and making recommendations for improvements.
- 9. Collegially shares, demonstrates and provides guidance regarding physical therapy treatments and programs to other therapists, students and other members of the multidisciplinary health care team.
- 10. Performs other related duties as assigned.

Educational & Professional Development.

- 11. To participate in and contribute to staff education programs.
- 12. To promote and interpret physiotherapy services to other health care personnel, students and to the public.

Graduation from a recognized university program in Physiotherapy. Current licensure in a practicing category with the College of Health and Care Professionals of BC as a Physiotherapist. Eligible for membership in the Canadian Physiotherapy Association (CPA).
