JOB SUMMARY:

In accordance with the Vision, Purpose, and Values, and strategic direction of Island Health (Vancouver Island Health Authority), patient and staff safety is a priority and a responsibility shared by everyone; as such, the requirement to continuously improve quality and safety is inherent in all aspects of this position.

The Victoria Regional Laundry is a centralized industrial laundry facility located in Victoria (adjacent to Victoria General Hospital), and services health care facilities on southern Vancouver Island. Reporting to the Maintenance Manager, Supervisor or designate, the Millwright / Laundry Mechanic works within a small, dedicated team to perform maintenance, repairs and equipment upgrades at the journeyman level in compliance with applicable codes, regulations and established procedures.

TYPICAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 1. Carries out inspections, preventive maintenance and repairs on a wide variety of automated laundry equipment such as washers, dryers, folders, compressors, conveyors, rail systems, pumps and other machinery by replacing and or/repairing components such as drive units, drive belts and chains, motors and control valves.
- 2. Installs, aligns, dismantles, moves, repairs and maintains industrial machinery and mechanical equipment, such as motors, pumps, fans, tanks, conveyors, pulleys, chains, gears, sprockets, clutches, gear boxes, hydraulic, and pneumatic systems.
- 3. Responds to equipment service calls. Troubleshoots and repairs automated laundry equipment to ensure production requirements are maintained.
- 4. Monitors and adjusts plant heating, ventilation and a variety of other automated equipment controlled by programmable logic controller or Reliable, Direct Digital Control system.
- 5. Assists in the design, fabrication and installation of new production equipment as well as the modification of existing equipment.
- 6. Assigns work tasks to designated staff and provides related training and orientation.
- 7. Monitors air handling unit and water system filter pressures and installs new filters as required to ensure optimal efficiency.
- 8. Maintains appropriate logs and maintenance records.
- 9. Operates a wide variety of hand tools and machine tools such as lathes and grinders to fabricate the parts required during overhauls, repairs, maintenance or set-up of machinery, as well as fabricating custom parts, fixtures and guards by means of arc welding, grinding, brazing, and oxyacetylene cutting.

- 10. Maintains and repairs of a large inventory of laundry carts.
- 11. Performs other related duties as assigned.
