TYPICAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

Food Service Workers:

As per the job description for the specific location you are hired to your duties will encompass more or less of the following but are not limited to

- Grade 10 plus one (1) year recent related experience or an equivalent combination of education, training and experience. Certificate in Food Safe Level 1.
- Assembles patient meal trays according to menu.
- Loads, delivers, collects, and unloads meal service wagons.
- Makes beverages and food items such as tea, coffee, and toast. Portions food for patients and staff according to specified requirements.
- Counts, weighs and measures ingredients.
- Assembles items such as sandwiches and salads.
- Washes dishes and utensils either by hand or machine.
- Stacks clean dishes and utensils, clears and cleans dining room tables.
- Portions out and serves food and beverages.
- Washes, peels and stores vegetable and fruit.
- Unpacks and stores grocery and produce deliveries; rotates stock; takes out and puts away supplies as required.
- Performs cleaning duties such as cleaning counter tops, sinks, cupboards, shelves, machines, and equipment and spot washes wall and splash areas.
- Answers phone and takes messages.
- Performs other related duties as required.

Full duties and responsibilities will be as per job description hired to.
